

Income-based contributions help make healthcare affordable

What does income-based contributions mean?

A member's contribution is determined by his/her gross monthly salary (income) received.

Example: Two members are on the PlatComprehensive Option

Member 1		Member 2	
Earns R17 000 per month and therefore falls in the R0 - R18 020 salary scale.	Monthly contribution is R1 550	Earns R28 000 per month and therefore falls in the R27 326+ salary scale.	Monthly contribution is R2 622
↓	↓	↓	↓
Salary Scale R0 - R18 020	Principal Member R1 550	Salary Scale R27 326+	Principal Member R2 622

Contribution Table for PlatComprehensive

Salary Scale	R0 - R18 020	R18 021 - R27 325	R27 326+
Principal Member	R1 550	R2 236	R2 622
